Contest Guidelines

1. Invitation:

The Filipino Association of University Women (FAUW), 3 Point Scholarship Hawaii, and Reiyukai America invite Hawaii K8 students to participate in the first annual Ohana Art Contest! The organizers aspire to promote stronger families that can affect stronger communities.

2. Theme and Prizes:

There are two categories and there will be three winners in each category:

● K-5 Division

Theme: My Favorite 'Ohana Moment

Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$75, 3rd \$50

Teacher Prize for 1st Placer: \$50 Amazon Gift Card

● 6-8 Division

Theme: 'Ohana

Prizes: 1st \$100, 2nd \$75, 3rd \$50

Teacher Prize for 1st Placer: \$50 Amazon Gift Card

3. Requirements and Criteria

3.1 Requirements:

- Drawing must be on a letter size paper (8.5" x 11")
Students may use crayons, colored pencils, markers, but not acrylic, watercolor, or oil.
- An original artwork that portrays the contestant's experiences with his/her 'ohana.
- A paragraph describing the artwork.
- Photographs, paintings, and other media other than student drawings will be disqualified.

3.2 Criteria for Judging

- Theme - Does the artwork convey the theme? (50 points)
- Originality - Does the student demonstrate originality in conveying the theme? (25 points)
- Impact - Does the artwork have visual impact? (25 points)

4: Schedule
